**\* Registration For Children -**

*Always need their original birth certificate and both parents sign application of form.*

**\* Certificate Of Indian Status -**

*Status cards provide two pieces of I.D.'s*

**\* Changed Of Address's -**

*Non- band member reside off reserve call Mosquito Band Office ask for Rossella Moosomin of new update address.*

**\* 18 of Age Own Treaty Number -**

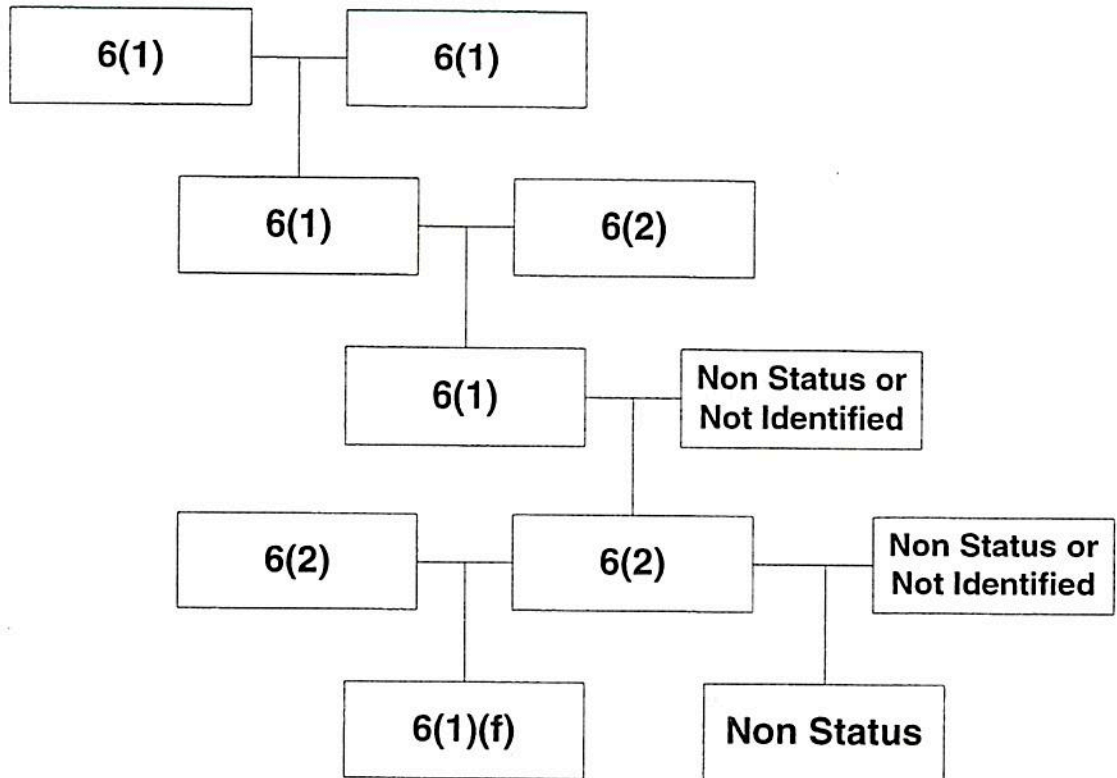
*The age of 18years old may apply for their own treaty number.*

**Section 6(2) cut-off** – The 1985 *Indian Act* introduced a cut-off in terms of who is entitled to registration. Persons born to a parent who is entitled under section 6(2) are not eligible for registration unless their other parent is also someone who is registered or entitled to be registered under the *Act*.

#### SECTION 7 – PERSONS CURRENTLY NOT ENTITLED TO REGISTRATION

The 1985 *Indian Act* describes the following persons as not entitled to be registered as Indians, even though they may have qualified for registration under section 6.

- 7(1)(a) A non-Indian woman by birth who, by marrying an Indian, acquired status under Section 11(1)(f) of the 1951 *Indian Act* (or under any former Acts) and then lost her status. She may have lost status through enfranchisement, or by subsequent marriage to a non-Indian male prior to April 17, 1985.

\* Note that if the subsequent marriage to a non-Indian was not reported to the Registrar prior to Bill C-31, and the woman was de facto registered immediately before April 17, 1985, then 7(1)(a) does not apply and the woman remains registered under Section 6(1)(a). See Judicial Decisions – Marchand Case.

- 7(2) Section 7(1)(a) does not apply to a woman who was eligible for registration in her own right (based on her Indian descent) under the provisions of this Act, at any time prior to being registered under 11(1)(f).
- 7(1)(b) A person whose (non-Indian by birth) mother acquired status under Section 11(1)(f) of the 1951 *Indian Act* and whose father is not an Indian.
